REGISTRATION LABELS



From 1 October 2014, all light vehicles under 4.5 tonnes will no longer be issued with registration labels.

This means no more handy reminder of the expiry date on your windscreen.

It will be your responsibility as a driver to check that your vehicle, or any other you intend to drive is registered.

The Department of Transport and Queensland Police Service will continue to enforce vehicle registration to ensure that vehicles on the road are registered.

Vehicles with expired registration will not be covered by insurance.

Police now have new technology to scan number plates, so drivers of vehicles with expired registration can expect an unwelcome bill in the mail.

As a free service, we are currently printing a replacement sticker to display your expiry date and we can fit this at your next service if required.
